

Book Creator - Peer Discussion & Feedback

**Step 1: (10 minutes) Reading**

Email your project to your partner. If you cannot send it, you can switch iPads. Read and listen to your partner's book. Do not discuss or ask any questions at this point.

**Step 2: (5 minutes) Mechanics Questions**

Use this time to ask questions about grammar or vocabulary that you did not understand.

**Step 3 (5 minutes): Feedback**

Craft one comment and two questions for your partner. You must foster the skill of comparing and contrasting.

**For Example:**

This aspect of your project is similar or different to mine because\_\_\_\_\_.

I am wondering how your findings are similar or different to \_\_\_\_\_.

Other possible comments or questions to consider.

How well did the creator of the book present the content in an engaging way?

Something that stands out to me (or confuses me) about your product is \_\_\_\_\_.

**Step 4: (8 minutes per person) Discussion of comments and questions- Speaking OR Listening (You will TAKE TURNS.)**

When you are the LISTENER, use the space below to take notes on any part of your discussion that you want to keep in mind.

**Step 5: (10 minutes) Reflection**

What did you learn from your partner? What key content did you take away after reading through your partner's Book Creator and discussing his/her work?

Finally, after talking about your work, are you able to develop any new ideas about what your final product might look like?
